EXAMINATIONS

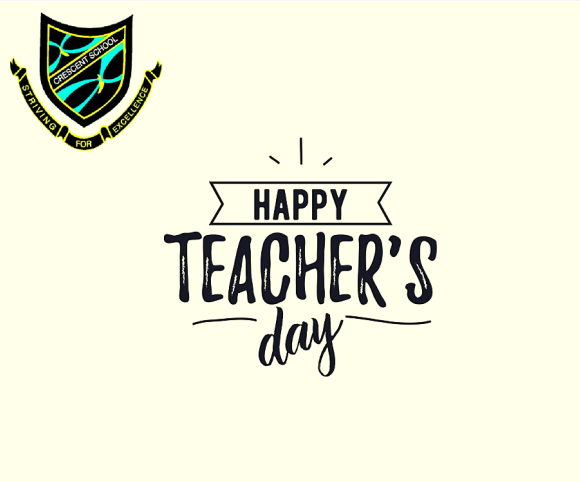

SECONDARY SATURDAY LESSONS

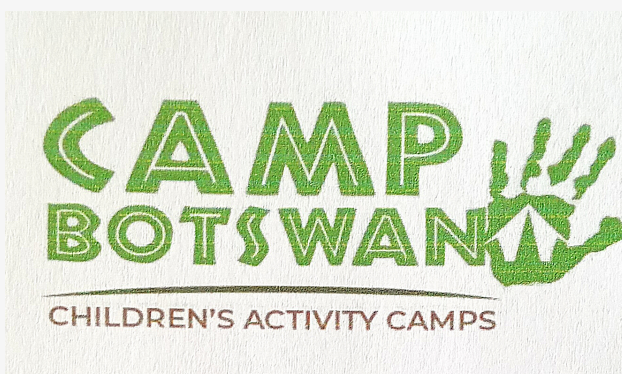

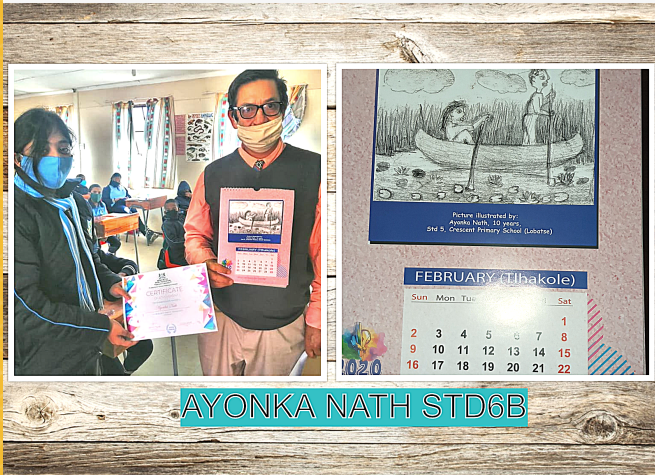
STD 7 STUDY SKILLS WORKSHOP

ART PRIZE WINNERS

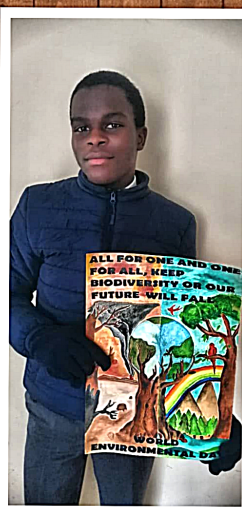
